An update on Disaster Management by the Quality Cell and Safety Cell

Safety of patients and staff ranks high on the list of goals of the institution. With a view to prepare the staff to handle the emergencies, the **Safety Cell and Quality Management Cell** along with the respective departments have developed various emergency protocols, trained the staff and conducted drills in theatre, wards, OPD services, ICUs and laboratories. Specific drills like **child abduction emergency drill in paediatric wards, radiation emergency drill evacuating brachytherapy and radio nuclide patients** were also conducted.






Mock drills for theatres are conducted once in 6 months, zone wise. During this drill, a major fire was simulated and the entire communication and evacuation process were observed by the Quality / Safety team who assess the operating team, individuals and offices for their response times and adherence to the prescribed protocols. Following the drill, all the participants gathered in the recovery area for debriefing. The suggestion and recommendation are to be noted and implemented.

Ward mock drills are conducted weekly as per the schedule which consists of one cycle covering every ward in the main campus. During the exercise, emergency evacuation protocol and the first response to fire were emphasized since it is the crucial step to confine the hazard and minimize the risk. After the briefing, the staff are asked to enact on the protocol including managing critical, semi-critical and non-critical patients. Fire scenario is initiated and the staff are asked to respond to it. The response is observed and the issues noted during the drill are discussed during debriefing. The noted issues are intimated to the concerned departments for rectification and follow up. The support from Nursing Service in conducting the drill and the response of the fire team during the drill is appreciated.

The protocol for handling ICU emergencies, mob violence management and bomb threat management has been developed through the series of meeting conducted by Quality / Safety teams along with concerned medical, nursing, fire, security and engineering teams. The Department Quality Managers have undergone the "Training the trainers programme on mob violence and bomb threat management"



The trained DQMs will in turn train the unit doctors. From mid August, the drills will commence for mob violence management. Special training on the same for security team was also conducted.
