



Dr. Vathsala Sadan, Dean, further explained about the student welfare measures available in the college. The students are mentored and guided in the college and hostel by the class advisors and the hostel warden. Freshers have special retreat conducted by chaplaincy department. The college has its own student welfare cell and counseling services, where in, a counselor is available even in the hostel for facilitating student counseling. The foster parent scheme allows each faculty member to have a foster parent for a group of students from all classes. The scheme facilitates a closer relationship between faculty and students thereby providing opportunities for sharing, counseling and guidance. The foster sister scheme among the students allows final year students to take care of



1/19: Foster Batch Scheme:

Senior students meeting with their fresh batch of freshers are discouraged for two months to prevent any risk of ragging.

2/19: Foster Parent Scheme:

Measures are taken to strengthen the foster parent scheme at the College which facilitates closer relationship between faculty and students. It is decided to have one day as "Foster Parents Day" to encourage students to meet their foster parent faculty for sharing, counseling and guidance.

3/19: Student Welfare Committee:

The activities of the student welfare committee are also strengthened. Mrs. Helen Charles, Professor, Mental Health Nursing and Registrar, College of Nursing will be the Chairperson of the committee. Measures and activities related to personality development, skill development and emotional well being are planned for the students' welfare.

4/19: "LeanonMe" - Counselling Programme:

Institution has introduced online counseling programme called "LeanonMe" which enables faculty and students to access counseling services on their smart phone by downloading "LeanonMe" app. Qualified, committed and empathetic counselors can be accessed to get emotional support through professional counseling and advisory services, that would help realize their potential and ability to either resolve, or cope with challenges and issues in life.

5/19: Internal Complaints Committee (ICC):

The Chair Person informed that POSH act demands , an ICC be made at all workplaces for the redressal of sexual harassment cases. Any aggrieved woman who can be an employee or a student in an Institution can approach ICC. One student representative will be included in the Institutional ICC when there is 'student issue' in the institution.

6/19:Visitors' Card:

Chairperson informed that the visitors cards are modified to include photographs of the visitors and the student on the card. Three visitors are allowed for each students.

7/19: Provision of Necessary Facilities :

Freshers are discouraged to go out for shopping for the first 3 months. Number of shopping days are reduced from 6 days to 3 days between 4.30-6.30 pm. ATM installation is done and provision of bakery and canteen services are planned inside the college campus to help the students from the struggle of going out.

8/19: Measures to prevent Ragging:

a. Session on " UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging was taken by Dr. Vathsala Sadan, Dean College of Nursing which was attended by the freshers and their parents. Freshers and their parents completed and signed the Anti-ragging affidavit on the day of joining the course.

b. The sessions on Anti-ragging was conducted for all the senior students to reinforce the importance of ragging free campus.

c. Booklet on Anti-ragging, prepared by College of Nursing, CMC was distributed to all the students. The contents of the booklet include UGC regulation on curbing the menace of ragging, details on Anti-ragging committee, numbers and websites for reporting incidents of ragging.


9/19: Suggestions from Committee Members:
