The topics discussed during the workshop are:

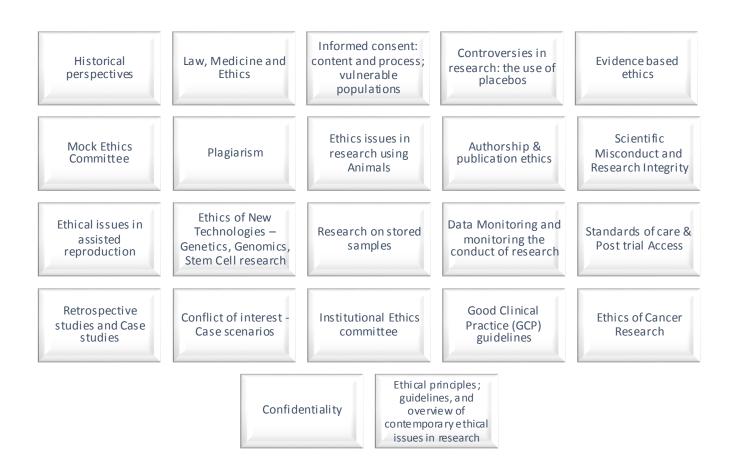

## Workshop on Manuscript Completion

Creating a well-crafted medical manuscript goes beyond conducting high-quality research. It involves effectively communicating findings, ensuring precision, presenting information attractively, and adhering to rigorous journal guidelines. To assist researchers in conveying their results and contributing to knowledge dissemination through various channels such as conference papers, reports, online journals, and print journals, Christian Medical College organizes a Manuscript Completion Workshop biannually, spanning three days each. The primary objective is to support participants in finalizing the write-up of their research findings or papers for submission.

This workshop caters to individuals who have completed data collection for their research projects, providing dedicated time for tasks like data entry, statistical analysis, and editing. Attendance is encouraged for up to three individuals associated with a particular project, with selection criteria based on a first-come-first-served basis, the nature of the project, and any urgency for swift publication. The number of delegates attended the workshop in 24/8/22 to 26/8/22 and 23/2/23 to 25/2/23 are 10 and 17 respectively.
